

BAC SUMMER ACADEMY 2012 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



BAC Summer Academy is a 4-week summer design exploration program for high school students entering grade 10 and above. The program, running from 9 AM–1:00 PM, Monday–Friday, with optional extended day Wednesdays until 4:00 PM, includes studio projects, site field trips, presentations and visits to Boston area design firms. We invite you to join us at the Boston Architectural College (BAC) this July to explore, create, and have fun as you gain a more complete understanding of the design world in this hands-on collaborative program. Tuition is \$1,800; all materials and supplies are included.

To cover the cost of BAC Summer Academy tuition, multiple awards are available in each of the following scholarship categories. Students may apply for one or both types of award. A single essay must be completed for either or both scholarships.

HOUSEMAN SUMMER ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP

The Houseman Scholarship Program aims to increase diversity among BAC students, graduates, and the design professions by making design education available to underrepresented groups in the profession. The Houseman Summer Academy Scholarship is awarded to prospective Summer Academy students (entering grades 10–12) based on their own diverse backgrounds. Upon completion of BAC Summer Academy, Houseman Scholars may apply to return the following year as Houseman Fellows to mentor incoming students. In addition, during their senior year, Houseman Scholars have the opportunity to apply for the Houseman Professional Program Scholarship, an award that covers a significant amount of tuition toward the professional undergraduate program of their choice at the Boston Architectural College.

SUMMER ACADEMY FINANCIAL NEED SCHOLARSHIP

Summer Academy Financial Need Scholarships are awarded to prospective BAC Summer Academy students based on financial need as well as their interest in exploring a career in design.

To be considered for a 2012 Houseman Summer Academy Scholarship and/or Summer Academy Financial Need Scholarship, an applicant must be permanent resident/U.S. Citizen and submit a completed application which includes:
