Summer Academy at the BAC is a four-week design exploration program offering hands-on experiences and an eye-opening education, from studio work and site field trips to presentations and visits to design firms.

Working individually and in teams, you will be introduced to the fundamental tools and creative problem-solving skills used in the fields of architecture, landscape architecture, interior design, and urban design. Each project is designed to be both challenging and fun.

DESIGN IS ALL AROUND US

The built environment that surrounds us defines how we live and how well we live. Design—in every realm—encompasses issues of beauty, utility, functionality, accessibility, sustainability, human health, and more. As a BAC Summer Academy student, you will begin to see the many creative ways these issues can be addressed.

Our program will introduce you to techniques of free-hand sketching, perspective drawing and collage, mapping, diagramming and model-making. You'll work on design problems that span the scales of the body, an individual building and the city's built and natural environment. Beyond these hands-on projects, you'll also gain

experience of the design field through lectures, presentations, and educational trips, including visits to local design firms.

The program ends with an exhibition and celebration of our students' work. You'll leave with projects that can strengthen a design portfolio, a clearer sense of whether this field appeals to you and a valuable understanding of how design can change communities and improve lives.
